### **Kaplan Admissions Exam On Campus Testing information**

**PRIOR TO APPLYING TO THE ADN PROGRAM**

**Applications to the Traditional programs which start August 2020 will only be accepted after the applicant has met the program benchmarks set for the Kaplan Admissions Exam. Program benchmarks are below.**

**Applicants may take the Kaplan Admissions Exam twice during an application process; September 1, 2019 through January 30, 2020. There is a required 2 week waiting period between exams. Scores will not be carried over from application period to application period.**

<b>Required Subject</b>	<b>ADN program Benchmark</b>
<b>• Reading</b>	<b>73% or higher</b>
<b>• Math</b>	<b>72% or higher</b>
<b>• Writing</b>	<b>61% or higher</b>
<b>• Science</b>	<b>53% or higher</b>
<b>• Overall</b>	<b>65% or higher</b>

**If the student does not meet the benchmark for Reading and Science, and obtain an overall benchmark of 65% they cannot go forward.**

**Please note: the last few weeks of testing prior to the January 30 deadline fill up quickly so testing opportunities will be limited.**

**It will take approximately 3 hours to complete this exam.**
