### LADY DRAGONS PLAY HOST TO CROWDER, HESSTON IN HCC CHRISTMAS CLASSIC

After having its eight-game winning streak snapped at the Jayhawk Shootout last weekend, the Hutchinson Community College women's basketball team looks to start a new winning streak this weekend at the HCC Women's Christmas Classic at the Sports Arena.

The Lady Dragons (9-1) play host to Crowder College (4-8) at 7:30 p.m. on Friday and Hesston College (7-8) at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday at the Sports Arena. The Bethany College Junior Varsity will be the fourth team in the field.

Both games will be broadcast live on the Blue Dragon Sports Network. Friday's airtime will be at 7:15 p.m. and Saturday's will be at 5:15 p.m.

Hutchinson split games last weekend at the 2008 Jayhawk Shootout. HCC fell for the first time this season, losing to host Coffeyville 63-61 in overtime, but rebounded in a big way to defeat Kansas City, Kansas 82-49 last Sunday.

The Lady Dragons fell out of the NJCAA national rankings after the loss,

but is still receiving votes in the latest poll.

Crowder suffered through a four-game losing streak in November, but is righting its ship, winning 3 of its last six games. HCC pummeled Crowder last season 75-40 at the Sports Arena.

Hesston College comes in losing two straight and is 0-4 in regional games. The Larks lost to Johnson County 66-54 on Wednesday night at Overland Park.

One win this weekend will give HCC its 25th 10-win non-conference season. The Lady Dragons have had 15-straight 10-win non-conference seasons.

**JOHN ONTJES FILE**

Former Blue Dragon basketball great John Ontjes became the Hutchinson Community College women's basketball program's sixth head coach on Aug. 9, 2007.

In his first season at HCC, Ontjes guided the Lady Dragons to a 24-8 record, which tied for the third-most wins in school history, a fourth-place league finish and a quarterfinal berth in the Region VI Tournament.

Ontjes is currently 33-9 at HCC.

An all-state athlete at Nickerson, Ontjes played for the Blue Dragons in 1992 and 1993. Ontjes' teams were a combined 56-12.

He ranks No. 1 in career assists (396) and

career steals (145). He also ranks first in single-season assists (230).

In 2005, Ontjes was voted by the fans onto the 75th Anniversary all-time Blue Dragon men's basketball team.

Ontjes took over the HCC women's basketball program after a successful two-year run as head girls basketball coach at Hutchinson High School. In just two seasons, he took a Salthawk girls program with very little varsity experience at the beginning and quickly molded it into a state tournament contender.

Hutchinson High went 10-11 in Ontjes' first season in 2005 using mainly underclassmen, including several freshmen. In 2006, the Salthawks qualified for the Class 5A state tournament and finished third in the state with a 19-6 overall record.

While playing at Oklahoma, Ontjes was named the Big Eight Newcomer of the Year after the 1994 season. He led OU averaging 6.5 assists per game, seventh on OU's single-season assist list. As a senior, Ontjes averaged 6.8 assists per game, which was fifth on the Oklahoma single-season assist list. He was named All-Big Eight honorable mention and to the Big Eight All-Underrated team.

With his 24 victories in his rookie season at HCC, Ontjes had more wins in his first year than any other Lady Dragon coach.

**LADY DRAGONS HOPE TO CONTINUE DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE IN '08-'09**

Over the last six seasons, the Lady Dragons have been one of the top defensive teams in the NJCAA.

So far this season, that hasn't changed. The Lady Dragons lead Region VI and are 12th in the nation in scoring defense at 52.0 points per game.

Thus far, HCC is allowing teams just 29.9 percent shooting, 28.9 percent from 3-point range. HCC is forcing 24.2 turnovers per contest.

In each of the last five seasons, HCC has been ranked in the Top 10 in defensive scoring average, including 2004 when the Lady Dragons were the top defensive team in the country, allowing a scant 48 points per game.

In head coach John Ontjes' first season in 2007-08, the Lady Dragons were eighth in the nation allowing 51.7 points per game. Opposing teams shot just 32.3 percent and just 24.7 percent from 3-point range. HCC held opponents to less than 40 points six times last season.

**HCC HAS HISTORICAL PERFORMANCES AGAINST BETHANY, TABOR JVs**

The Lady Dragons did some re-writing of the record books in a pair of blowout wins over the Bethany College and Tabor College junior varsity squads on Nov. 22 and Nov. 25, respectively.

Against Bethany, the Lady Dragons pounded the Swedes 95-34. The 95 points tied for the seventh-most points by the HCC women and was the seventh-largest margin of victory in a game.

Four days later, Hutchinson scored 100 points in a game for the first time since 1994 and for just the fifth time in program history in a 102-46 win over Tabor College. The 56-point margin of victory was the 11th largest in program history.

It's the first time in program history that HCC has scored 90 points or more in back-to-back games.

**LADY DRAGONS IN NJCAA RANKINGS**

After breaking into the NJCAA Division I women's national rankings last week, HCC's first loss of the season sent the Lady Dragons' back out of this week's national poll.

The Lady Dragons continue to receive votes in the latest poll. Coffeyville, the team that knocked HCC from the unbeaten ranks, is also receiving votes.

Former and future Lady Dragon opponents to be ranked are: South Plains (No. 14), Cloud County (No. 15).

**SERIES HISTORIES AGAINST  
CHRISTMAS CLASSIC OPPONENTS**

● **Crowder College** - The Lady Dragons look to even the all-time series record against Crowder. This will be the 16th meeting with Crowder leading the series 8-7.

Hutch has won two straight, including a 75-40 victory last season at the Sports Arena. The Lady Dragons have won 6 of the last 7 against Crowder after the Lady Riders won 7 of the first 8 series meetings.

● **Hesston College** - This will be the 20th meeting between HCC and Hesston College. The Lady Dragons are 18-1 against the Larks, winning 17 straight.

The only win for Hesston in the series came in 1976. Since then, the closest game in the series was 15 points, a 59-44 HCC win in 2004.

**LAST WEEK IN REVIEW**

● **Coffeyville** - The Lady Dragons had their eight-game winning streak to start the season snapped when Coffeyville nipped Hutchinson 63-61 in overtime on Dec. 5 at the Jayhawk Shootout in Coffeyville.

HCC led by seven points in the second half and by four with 2:28 left in regulation, but Coffeyville's Niasa Drake hit a putback at the buzzer to give Hutchinson its first loss of the season.

Freshman Naudia Campbell had her fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds. Freshman Heather Robben had 11 points and sophomore Brittany Hines finished with 10. Freshman Ariella McGhee and sophomore Lauren Sparks both had eight points. McGhee also had 11 rebounds.

The Lady Dragons were outrebounded for the first time this season, 53-39, with Coffeyville pulling down 20 offensive boards.

● **Kansas City** - Freshman Heather Robben scored a team and individual season-high 24 points to lead the Lady Dragons to an 82-49 Jayhawk Shootout victory over Kansas City, snapping a three-game Shootout losing streak.

Robben, who hit a huge 3-pointer to end the first half, took charge late in the half, scoring eight points during an 11-3 run to close the half. Robben continued her strong play in the second half, helping HCC outscore Kansas City 46-20 in the final 20 minutes. HCC shot 60.7 percent (17 of 28) in the second half.

Four Lady Dragons scored in double figures. Freshman Ariella McGhee had 14 points, seven rebounds and a season- and team-high seven steals. Sophomore Briyana Evans finished with 12 points and sophomore Lauren Sparks had 10 points.

Freshman point guard Sasha King finished with four points, but had eight assists to no turnovers.

The Lady Dragons shot 48.3 percent overall (29 of 60) and was 6 of 23 from 3-point range.

Kansas City's bench provided the Blue Devils much of its offense, scoring 36 of the team's 49 points.

- Freshman center Naudia Campbell is tied for 40th in the NJCAA in rebounding at 8.5 boards per game.
- Sophomore guard Lauren Sparks is 35th in 3-point field goal percentage at 44.0 percent.
- Freshman guard Heather Robben is 21st in free-throw percentage at 84.8 percent.
- The Lady Dragons are ranked No. 12 in the NJCAA in team defensive scoring average at 52.0 points per game.
- The Lady Dragons are ranked No. 13 in team free-throw percentage at 68.4 percent.
- The Lady Dragons are ranked No. 27 in the NJCAA in team scoring offense at 78.1 points per game.
- The Lady Dragons are ranked No. 28 in team field goal percentage at 44.4 percent.
- The Lady Dragons are ranked No. 36 in team 3-point percentage at 33.3 percent.

**LADY DRAGONS AIM FOR ANOTHER 10-WIN NON-CONFERENCE SEASON**

Going into this weekend 9-1, the Lady Dragons will aim for another 10-win non-conference season.

Last year's 11-3 record gave HCC 24 10-plus win non-conference seasons, including 15 in a row.

That tied for the fifth-most non-conference victories in a season, joining the 1986-87, 1990-91, 1998-99 and 2002-03 teams with 11 wins.

Thirteen other HCC teams have had more non-conference victories than the 2007-08 team. The record for non-conference wins is 18 set by the 1989-90 team. The 1987-88 and 2001-02 teams are second with 14 wins.

After the HCC Christmas Classic, the Lady Dragons have two more non-conference games at Grayson County and Collin County, Texas., on Nov. 28 and 29.

**McGHEE TIES 22-YEAR-OLD LADY DRAGON REBOUNDING RECORD**

Freshman Ariella McGhee was a rebounding machine in a 75-68 victory over Marshalltown on Nov. 8.

McGhee pulled down 17 rebounds, which tied a 22-year-old single-game HCC women's record. Penny Fisher owned the record, grabbing per 17 rebounds in a 1986 game.

The record was approached twice last season when Amanda Fessenden had 15 rebounds twice.

**LADY DRAGONS PROGRAM IS A CONSISTENT WINNER**

HCC started women's basketball in 1974. The Lady Dragons have amassed a record of 662-316. The 1977 team won the only Region VI championship and finished fourth in the nation.

The Lady Dragons have been consistent winners, notching winning records in 32 of 34 seasons. Hutchinson has had at least 20 wins in a season 18 times and has won at least 15 games in 28 of 34 seasons.

The Lady Dragons notched their 18th 20-win season on Feb. 13, 2008 with a 74-39 victory over Dodge City at the Sports Arena.

The 2007-08 Lady Dragons have 24 victories this season, which ties for the third-most wins in a season, matching the 1997-98 team (24-8) and the 1999-2000 team (24-8).

**HOME COOKING GOOD TO LADY DRAGONS**

The Lady Dragons are 359-108 all-time in 34 seasons at the Sports Arena.

Win No. 350 came in a 67-62 victory over No. 19 Cloud County on March 1, 2008. HCC's 300th victory at the Sports Arena was a 54-44 win over Neosho County on Nov. 28, 2003.

Only twice have the Lady Dragons been undefeated in a season at home. They were 10-0 in 1977 and 8-0 in 1978. The 1999-2000 team posted an 18-3 home record, which are the most victories in a single season as the Sports Arena.

The 2007-08 Lady Dragons were 16-1 at the Sports Arena.

**LADY DRAGONS TOPPLE NO. 9 SOUTH PLAINS**

Freshman Ariella McGhee posted her third double-double of the season and the Lady Dragons remained unbeaten by knocking off No. 9-ranked South Plains College, Texas, 65-59 in the final game of the 2008 HCC Women's Thanksgiving Classic on Saturday night at the Sports Arena.

The Lady Dragons (8-0) held South Plains (11-2) to its second-lowest point total and lowest shot percentage of the season en route to their first victory over a nationally ranked opponent this season.

McGhee had 13 points and 15 rebounds for her third double-double in eight games. McGhee's rebounding performance was key in HCC outrebounding a quick and big South Plains front line 42-40.

Freshman Naudia Campbell added 12 points, eight rebounds and two blocked shots. Sophomores Brittany Hines and Briyana Evans and freshman Heather Robben scored nine points each. Sophomore Lauren Sparks had seven points.

The Lady Dragons shot 37.7 percent overall (20 of 53) and was 3 of 7 from 3-point range (42.9 percent). HCC's key stat was going 22 of 26 from the free-throw line, 14 of 17 in the second half.

South Plains, coached by former HCC women's basketball assistant Michelle Wyatt, was held to a season-low 31.1 percent (19 of 61), going 6 of 13 from 3-point range and 15 of 20 from the free-throw line. Dayon Hall-Jones had a game-high 18 points to lead the Lady Texans, while leading scorer Taniqua Ards was held to 11 points. Sajoyia Griffin hit three 3-point goals and had 11 points.

**HCC RALLIES FROM 20 DOWN TO TOPPLE MARSHALLTOWN**

Sophomore Brittany Hines scored a career-high 23 points and freshman Ariella McGhee tied a team rebounding record to power a huge comeback against on the final night of the Grand Prairie Hotel Classic on Nov. 8.

HCC trailed by 20 points in the first half, but battled back to defeat Marshalltown 75-68.

Hines ignited the second-half rally scoring 13 points in helping HCC outscore Marshalltown (3-1) 44-25 in the final 20 minutes. Hines finished shooting 8 of 10 from the field, including 2 of 2 from 3-point range.

McGhee tied a 22-year-old team record pulling down 17 rebounds on Saturday night. McGhee broke the 1986 record of 17 by Penny Fischer.

But individual efforts were overshadowed by HCC's comeback from a 20-point first-half deficit. Marshalltown hit 8 of its first 16 shots and built a 24-4 lead with 9:50 to play in the first half after a Megan Stanton 3-point goal. Hutchinson, over the first 10 minutes was just 1 of 9 shooting.

The Lady Dragons slowly started to turn things around in the latter stages of the opening half. A Hines basket with 7:32 to play capped a 12-3 Lady Dragon run to cut the deficit to single digits at 24-16. HCC trailed 43-31 at halftime.

Hutch eventually erased the entire 20-point deficit midway through the second half and then dominated the final 10 minutes of the game, completing a 33-point turnaround, building a 13-point lead with 3:14 to play in the game.

**LADY DRAGONS PICKED TO FINISH FOURTH  
IN JAYHAWK WEST**

The Lady Dragons were picked to finish fourth in the 2009 Jayhawk West championship race this season by a vote of the league's coaches.

Cloud County, ranked No. 7 in the preseason NJCAA poll, was the coaches' choice to win the West championship. Preseason No. 17 Seward County was picked to finish second and defending Jayhawk West and Region VI champion Barton Community College was picked third.

**HOME/SEASON-OPENING SUCCESS**

Season and home openers have usually meant success for the Lady Dragons. The Lady Dragons are now 28-7 in season openers and have won the last seven straight. The last loss was 50-48 setback to Howard College on 2000. The HCC women are even better in home openers, going 31-4 in those games. HCC won the 2005-06 home opener 60-37 over the McPherson College JV. The Lady Dragons have won nine straight season openers. The last loss in an opener at the Sports Arena was 68-67 to Northern Oklahoma in 1997. HCC's 79-14 season opening victory this season was the largest home-opening margin of victory, which was also the third largest in history. The most points scored in a home opener was 88, which happened twice. Hutch won 88-42 over Brown Mackie College in 1995. That tied the 1980 opener against Allen County in which Hutch poured in 88 points.

**2008-09 LADY DRAGONS TO LEAN ON SOPHOMORES**

The Lady Dragons have four returning guards from last year's 24-8 team that lost to Independence in the Region VI quarterfinals. Those four returning players represent 33 percent of the scoring, 18 percent of the rebounding and 43 percent of the 3-pointers made from last season. Kylee Naccarato, a 5-foot-7 sophomore from Hutchinson, is the leading returning scorer who averaged 6.7 points per game and shot 47.3 percent from 3-point range. Brittany Hines, a 5-6 sophomore from Hutchinson (Buhler High School), averaged 6.1 points and shot 28 percent from long range. Lauren Sparks, a 5-6 sophomore from Wollengong, Australia, averaged 6.6 points and tied for the team lead with 86 assists. Briyana Evans is a 5-7 sophomore from Southfield, Mich. She averaged just under a point per game last season.

**NATALIE PURCELL IS HCC'S FIRST-EVER HOOPS OLYMPIAN**

Hutchinson Community College had its first female athlete ever to compete in the Olympics when Natalie Purcell played for the New Zealand women's national team in the 2008 Summer Games in Beijing. Purcell was the first HCC athlete to compete in the Olympics since Steve Fritz finished fourth in the decathlon in the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta. Purcell, a 6-foot forward who played at Hutchinson in 2002-03 and 2003-04, was an All-Jayhawk Conference performer for the Lady Dragons in 2004. She was the 2003-04 team's leading scorer and rebounder averaging 11.5 points and 7.6 rebounds. Purcell was one of the team's top 3-point shooters with 33. Purcell had 16 points and 11 rebounds in a 64-50 victory over Seward County, which snapped the Saints' 135-game home-court winning streak. Purcell played in all five New Zealand games, averaging 3.2 points. She had an Olympics-high six points in a loss to the United State. New Zealand went 1-4 in pool play.
