What is the ATI TEAS?

The ATI Teas (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is designed to specifically assess a students' preparedness entering the health science fields. Most likely, you've been asked to take the TEAS as part of your basic admissions requirements for your nursing or allied health program. That's because studies show a consistent link between a student's performance on the TEAS and future academic success.

The ATI TEAS exam is comprised of 170 questions, 20 of which are unscored pretest items. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform in class in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science and English and Language Usage.

How to register for the TEAS at HutchCC:

PLEASE NOTE THIS EXAM IS DESIGNED TO BE TAKEN AT HOME. If you do not have access to internet and a computer with a working camera and microphone, please contact ADN@hutchcc.edu for additional information.

Step 1: Create ATI account at www.atitesting.com. If you already have an account skip to Step 3.

- On the institution info page, please select **Hutchinson CC Hutchinson ADN**
- For future graduation date, please select **non-degree seeking box**.

Step 2: You will see a screen with three TEAS Registration options. Select **Through my institution or testing center**.
PLEASE NOTE: This exam is designed for you to take the exam at home using a computer with a strong internet connection, working camera and microphone.

Step 3: Click **Sign In** to get to your ATI Student Account

Step 4: On your student home page, you can see your name in the upper right-hand corner. You can click to update any profile information here.

Click on **My ATI** to access your remote proctoring Dry Run to test your system.

- You will be using Proctorio for your proctored exam. You must complete the **DRY RUN** before exam day to make sure your system is ready to go.
- Note – if you do not have Remote Proctoring with Proctorio Dry Run card on the Test tab, enter this Assessment ID: 17970862, Password: Demo

Step 5: On the student HOME or TEST page, click **Add Product** in the upper-right corner to open the **Add Product** window.

- You will input the HutchCC ADN **Assessment ID: 37395413** and then it will take you through the steps eventually input your card information for the \$75 cost.
- Click **CONTINUE**. A confirmation message displays when your product has been added. The Before you Begin page opens.

Please Note: Exam scheduling is not completed through your ATI account.

Step 6: Must schedule test date/time from calendar on next page. All testing is remote proctored via both Proctorio and HutchCC. For questions or to schedule your exam select the date/time you would like to test from the calendar on the next page and email ADN@hutchcc.edu.

Step 7: Test Day

Log into your ATI account and select your TEAS Admission exam. Once it populates into our system, we will start the exam.

Step 8: To take the ATI TEAS a second time. Log into your ATI account, click **Add Product** in the upper-right corner to open the **Add Product** window.

- You will input the HutchCC ADN **Assessment ID: 37395469** and then it will take you through the steps eventually input your card information for the \$75 cost.
- Click **CONTINUE**. A confirmation message displays when your product has been added. The Before you Begin page opens.

Helpful tips to remember for the TEAS:

- Photo ID required.
- If your server goes down, simply close your browser window, log in again, and click back into the test. You will be able to resume the test where you left off.
- You should have nothing with you while taking the test (no cell phones, books, bags, etc.).
- Close all other programs and/or windows on the testing computer prior to logging into the proctored test environment.
- You will immediately be able to view the test results.

Test Environment

The online testing environment should mimic the “in class” testing environment, and must conform to the following:

- No leaving the room. You are allowed a 10-minute break after the Math section. <https://help.atitesting.com/do-you-allow-bathroom-breaks-during-the-online-teas-exam>
- Sit at a clean desk or clean table (not on a bed or couch)
- Lighting in the room must be bright enough to be considered “daylight” quality. Overhead lighting is preferred; however, if overhead is not possible, the source of light should not be behind the student.
- Be sure the desk or table is clear of all other materials. This means removal of all books, papers, notebooks, etc. You may have blank paper and a pen or pencil for calculations; you must show this into the camera when scanning the room. Be sure to show both sides of the paper. You may use the built-in calculator or your own may not be the one on your phone.
- External cameras, when possible, should be placed on the lid of the laptop or where it will have a constant, uninterrupted view of the test taker. Please make sure that the test taker is centered in the camera view.
- Close all other programs and/or windows on the testing computer prior to logging into the proctored test environment.
- Do not have a radio, music or the television playing in the background.
- Do not talk to anyone else – No communicating with others by any means with the exception of contact with proctor/support persons.
- No other persons except the test-taker should be permitted to enter the room during testing.

Behavior:

- Dress as if in a public setting
- You must not take the computer into another room to finish testing (exam must be completed in the same room the “Exam Environment View” is completed in).
- No use of headsets, headphones, Bluetooth, and ear buds or ear plugs (or similar audio devices) are permitted.
- Have the webcam correctly situated: webcam must be focused on the individual taking the exam at all times. Nothing covering the lens of the camera at any time during the exam.
