For CPR Instructor Card

The CPR Instructor video will be used for the monitoring process that is required for each CPR Instructor every 2 years. Your completed video will meet the requirement of a face to face classroom monitoring session.

The video does not need to be professionally developed.

The submitted video will be viewed and the monitoring tool completed. After the instructor has demonstrated competencies and professional behaviors the AHA BLS Instructor card will be issued.

Refer to the AHA Instructor Monitoring Tool form for competencies and Indicators used for assessment:

- Professional course delivery
- Visual documentation of AHA course materials: 2015 Guidelines DVD, Instructor material, student manuals and other support documents (skill sheets, exam answer sheet if using BLS, evaluation)
- Visual documentation of professional CPR equipment: adult manikin, baby manikin, simple mask, one-way valve, BVM if teaching BLS, gloves, AED trainer, manikin wipe or other cleaning means
- Visual documentation of AV equipment at recording using AHA CPR DVD: projector, computer, TV, video player or other way of presentation
- Demonstration of a skill instruction by instructor (of instructor choice)
- Return demonstration of skill by simulated student, remediation of student during skills practice, providing feedback
