## **Additional Information:**

The employee(s) you send will be representing your agency. They **must register** on-line to have their name on the event roster and to receive any event information and notifications.

Fuel for service vehicles is provided on arrival, during operations, and at the end of the event.

Lodging is provided. Please bring your own toiletries and bedding items. Lodging is barrack style with male/female showers. Air conditioning is not available.

We encourage sending a least one paramedic with 2 years field experience to fill the role of mentor. If one is not available, another mentor will be assigned.
