PARTNERSHIP

Once all the general education/liberal arts classes are completed, which can be taken at HutchCC and transferred to KU (approximately 60 hours), you will be able to complete both the ADN from HutchCC and BSN from KU at the same time, saving both time and money! The level of education remains quality as two nursing education powerhouses in the state partner together. Students take face-to-face instruction at HutchCC while taking KU Nursing classes online.

STEPS:

- 1. Apply to Hutchinson Community College and declare the pre-nursing major.
- 2. Complete all required general education/prerequisite courses with a 2.75 GPA or higher for HutchCC ADN admission. General Education credits from other regionally accredited institutions may be accepted.
- 3. Take ATI TEAS Exam and meet required benchmarks.
- 4. Apply and be accepted into HutchCC's Nursing Program through the institution's application process.
- 5. Apply and be accepted into KU School of Nursing Program through the institution's application process.
- 6. Complete 38 hours of nursing curriculum face-to-face at HutchCC and approximately 30 hours of nursing curriculum online through the KU School of Nursing.
- 7. Upon graduation from HutchCC, student will be eligible to apply for the NCLEX-RN licensure exam.

Once you are done, graduate as a HutchCC Blue Dragon and KU Jayhawk!

PROGRAM DETAILS:

- The nursing partnership model is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), and the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).
- Students may enter the HutchCC and KU Nursing programs in the fall semester.
- A student cannot progress in the KU Partnership if they do not progress in the HutchCC program.
- The HutchCC/KU Partnership is for students seeking both an associate's and bachelor's degree in nursing.
- Clinicals are included in the HutchCC curriculum.
- KU classes will be taken during the fall, spring, and summer semesters (online classes).
- Students are required to take a minimum of six credit hours within the KU nursing curriculum each semester in addition to the semester coursework for HutchCC.
- · Graduate with your ADN & BSN at the same time.
