

**Articulation Agreement Between  
Hutchinson Community College and Kansas State University**

**November 9, 2023**

Hutchinson Community College (HutchCC) and Kansas State University (K-State) agree to provide the courses listed on the attached curriculum guide as a joint education program that will enable students to meet the requirements for the Associate of Science Chiropractic-Transfer degree at HutchCC and the Bachelor of Science degree at K-State. It is also agreed that the courses required for the Associate of Science degree at HutchCC will be accepted by K-State as meeting the requirements for the first two years of the Bachelor of Science degree in Athletic Training and Rehabilitation Sciences at K-State, as shown in the attached curriculum guide.

HutchCC and K-State agree to provide student support services including admissions, academic advising, library access, technical support and other services as reasonably needed and appropriate. The staffs at both institutions will use best efforts to coordinate their student services to assure a smooth transition from one institution to the other.

HutchCC and K-State will continue to review the course offerings on the attached curriculum guide annually and will collaboratively adopt any mutually agreed upon revisions by written agreement. Any revisions or changes will continue to apply toward degree completion for the programs in this agreement. HutchCC and K-State will assure that all students who begin this program will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to complete the program within a reasonable period of time.

HutchCC and K-State will ensure that all students who begin and remain active and in good standing in this program will be able to complete the degree within a reasonable period of time according to a curriculum plan designed and communicated between the student and their advisor(s). Students who are not consistently enrolled in either HutchCC or K-State courses as outlined in the curriculum plan are not eligible for the benefits of the agreement. The guidelines for the curriculum plan are included with this agreement and provide the student with courses which fulfill general education requirements.

HutchCC and K-State agree that all students who successfully complete the requirements for the courses listed in the attached curriculum guide, and who have met other institutional requirements for the degrees, will be granted the specified degrees. Admission to K-State and the satisfaction of all degree requirements includes specific requirements as outlined in the K-State Catalog.

K-State and HutchCC will mutually promote and market this program.


This agreement is subject to annual review by HutchCC and K-State. This agreement is entered into pursuant to Chapter III, Section A.2.e of the Kansas Board of Regents Policy Manual and is subject to applicable law and policies of the Kansas Board of Regents and the institutions' respective accrediting agencies. Either party may discontinue this agreement by giving the other party written notice to that effect at least twelve months in advance of its plans to discontinue. However, in the event of such notice, all students then actively participating in an approved program under this agreement and in good academic standing will be allowed an opportunity to complete their program within a reasonable period of time.

After five years, on November 9, 2028, this agreement will end except as to students then-actively participating in an approved program under this agreement and in good academic standing, who will be allowed an opportunity to complete their program within a reasonable period of time. If the parties wish to continue a similar arrangement as outlined here, a new curriculum guide should be created and a new agreement signed.

Students are able to take the non-highlighted courses in addition to the requirements for the associate's degree up to 75 hours; however, this is not directly outlined in this 2+2 articulation agreement and may require additional departmental approval.
