Academic Articulation Agreement between Hutchinson Community College Hutchinson, KS and Wichita State University Wichita, KS for the Bachelor of Sciences in Medical Laboratory Sciences (MLS) (AS Pre-Medical Laboratory Science to BS MLS)

The purpose of the 2+2 Agreement is to provide Hutchinson Community College's students with a four-year coordinated program where students will receive an **Associate of Science degree in Pre-Medical Laboratory Sciences** at Hutchinson Community College (HutchCC) in the first two years and a Bachelor of Sciences in Medical Laboratory Sciences degree from Wichita State University (WSU) after two additional years. By this agreement, HutchCC and WSU express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to, and success in, higher education. This agreement will provide guidance for both parties in advising students.

This agreement is for Hutchinson Community College students who have:

- Earned an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree according to the attached plan.
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and a grade of C or higher in each prerequisite course.
- Completed all required MLS prerequisite courses, with the exceptions of MLS 311 and MLS 405, which must be successfully completed during the first semester at Wichita State.
- Applied for admission to Wichita State University as a Health Science Pre-Medical Laboratory Sciences major.

Hutchinson Community College students meeting the above requirements will:

- Enter Wichita State with junior status toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Submit an application to the professional MLS program early in their first semester at Wichita State. Admission to the professional program is not guaranteed.

This partnership reflects the following objectives, institutional expectations, and operational principles:

- All students must complete all major, institutional, and required degree requirements appropriate to the program curricula at the degree-granting institution to graduate.
- Both Hutchinson Community College and Wichita State University Medical Laboratory Sciences program faculty and administrators will promote the program with qualified prospective students

To ensure a successful transition and completion of the associate and bachelor's degrees from both institutions in this 2+2 agreement, students should refer to the required degree plans or stipulations of this agreement. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours of upper-division work to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University.

Terms of Agreement:

The agreement will begin with the 2024-2025 academic year.

Modification of Agreement

This agreement shall only be modified in writing with the same formality as the original agreement.

Termination of Agreement

Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason with a written notice from either party. The parties agree that termination shall require an advance notification of one year and agree that students enrolled in the program at the time of termination shall be permitted to complete the program as described herein. This agreement is a collaboration between Wichita State University and HutchCC. Any changes, corrections, or additions to this agreement shall be in writing and signed by all necessary parties between both academic institutions.

ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

WSU requires a minimum of 120 total hours to graduate. This includes any transferred hours from a regionally accredited school. The MLS program is 54 credit hours, **but students will take at least 6** credit hours at Wichita State (MLS 311 & 405) prior to starting the program.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

HutchCC students who earn an associate degree in Pre-Medical Laboratory Sciences with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average, will be eligible to matriculate to the WSU academic program in place for that catalog year if the student completes all program prerequisites and admission requirements successfully. HutchCC transfer students will have access to financial aid, scholarships, and student services on a similar basis as any other student.

WSU will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to HutchCC transfer students as applicable to any other student in the same catalog year.
