Definitions

Student Definitions	
In-District Student	A student who resides in the home county of the college and where taxes to support the college are therefore levied.
Out-of-District Student	A student who is a Kansas resident, but not a resident of the college's home county, where taxes to support the college are levied.
Out-of-State Student	A student who is not a resident of the state of Kansas.
International Student	A student who is not a resident of the United States.
Fee Definitions	
Facility Fee	Outreach site lease costs.
Online Course Fee	Support costs for online education expenses and college internet infrastructure and service.
Hybrid Course Fee	Support costs for online education expenses and college internet infrastructure and service.
Secondary Blended Online Fee	Cost of delivery of blended online
Tiered Course Fee	Additional cost to deliver CTE courses as defined by tiered funding (excluding PN, Cosmetology & Excel in CTE Reimbursement)
Course Fee	Equipment, test fees, rental fees, uniforms, supplies, software access, and background checks.
Lab Fee	For replacement and maintenance of equipment, materials and supplies used in the lab.
Materials Fee	To cover the cost of consumable materials
Tool Fee	For tools the student receives
