Articulation Agreement Amendment Between Hutchinson Community College and Kansas State University Original Agreement Date: December 1, 2023

This Amendment to the articulation agreement between Hutchinson Community College and Kansas State University, originally signed on December 1, 2023 for the programs Associate of Science in Nutrition-Dietetics and Bachelors of Science in Dietetics, is made for the purpose of updating course information to reflect recent curricular changes.

The following updates are agreed upon by both institutions:

- 1. CH 108 Principles of Organic and Biochemistry at Hutchinson Community College will no longer be accepted as equivalent to CHM 350/351 General Organic Chemistry and Lab at Kansas State University. Instead, CH 108 will now transfer as BIOCH 265 Intro to Organic and Biochemistry.
- For students pursuing the Nutrition-Dietetics, AS at HutchCC and the Dietetics BS at Kansas State University, the articulation agreement is updated to require CH 201 Organic Chemistry I at HutchCC to fulfill the degree requirement for CHM 350/351 at Kansas State University.

These changes will take effect beginning with the **Summer 2025** term and apply to all students entering the program on or after that term.

All other terms and conditions outlined in the original articulation agreement dated **December 1**, **2023** remain in effect. This amendment does not alter the structure, duration, or intent of the original agreement.
